The Center for Research on College-Workforce Transitions (CCWT) is looking for 3-4 student (undergraduate or graduate) interns to help us design and implement our research and policy analysis programs. Our work includes a multi-state study of college internships, student-led action research, policy analysis, and community engagement around issues of career pathways, social justice, and student learning.

In 2019, we're especially looking for detail-oriented, independent, and organized Interns to:

- Conduct a literature review on work-based learning in Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSIs)
- Assist with research subject recruitment for study on college internships
- Assist with project(s) engaged in regional strategic planning for school-college-career pathways
- Prepare research and policy briefs for diverse audiences (media, policymakers, educators, employers)
- Assist with communications and social media strategy of the Center

Interns will work between 5-10 flexible hours a week, earn an hourly wage, and gain valuable, real-world experience in research and policy analysis.
